

If the printer definitions require reset each time the program is started this is probably due to the permission setting on the client computer.

CodeBase Error -930 and/or invalid parameter -93308 d4numFields may be generated.

FormSmith allows each computer on the network to designate it's own printers. This printer information is stored in the file \Program Files\esw\Printer.dbf

Therefore, the program (esw.exe on the server) should be able to read/write into program folder (and all sub-folders) on client computer:

[mapped drive letter] + \Program Files (x86)\esw\

If setting the read/write permission fails, it is possible to relocate printer definitions on the client computer. To do this add this startup switch to the startup icon:

/cx/s

eg: ... \esw.exe" /cs/s

The /cs switch says that this program is running as a client. The /s relocates the local files (Printer.dbf and History.txt) to \Users\Public\esw\

Note: add a space before switches -> ... \esw.exe" /cs/s NOT ... \esw.exe"/cx/s
Important: This switch is only allowed to be used on client computers.

It is also possible to set a switch that instructs the program not to check for installed printers - use the default printer:

/H

When this switch is used, the margins necessary for printing claim forms are not set.
